Bokang Keikantseng was unemployed and at the time of the training had been turned down for a job at the local Wimpy. She re-applied once she completed the course and is now a teller at the WIMPY due to her new found digital literacy skills.



Louisa Putu was unemployed and she has now been appointed as an admin clerk at LD Matshego Primary School. She works three days a week.
