



Intel® Launches new Course for Leaders in Education

Leading Sustainable Change is a workshop for education leaders who want to create an educational technology plan for their schools. The goal of this workshop is to guide educational leaders through the process of change as they implement, or plan implementation, of their technology integration plans. Through guided discussions and hands-on activities, leaders will learn and apply the key drivers that make for successful and sustainable change in practice.

The five modules in this course are as follows:

Module 1, **Educational Change Transformation**, is about the principles of change management and change leadership in education. Leaders will consider best practices for educational change transformation and begin the necessary steps to facilitate implementation of a technology plan.

Module 2, **Defining the Opportunity**, explores how to build a “Big Opportunity” statement that communicates a sense of urgency for achieving transformative change in schools. Leaders will prepare to communicate a “Big Opportunity” to get buy-in from stakeholders.

Module 3, **Creating and Supporting a Climate of Change**, helps leaders to build a core leadership team to carry out the technology plan, influence others, and think strategically while implementing educational initiatives.

Module 4, **Implementing and Managing Change**, continues to build the leadership team’s communication skills while embracing resistance and addressing adaptive challenges that may occur during change implementation.



Module 5, **Sustaining Change through Continuous Improvement**, explores how to lead change through continuous improvement and self-evaluation and sustain change by defining incremental objectives and celebrating milestones.
