"What sets the SchoolNet SA conference apart from other EdTech events is the focus on teachers' learning about best practices, integrating digital tools and collaborative projects from other teachers and international experts, and, experiencing practical, hands-on sessions to try out different tools for teaching and learning," says SchoolNet SA Executive Director Omashani Naidoo.

"We anticipate that this conference, will inspire teachers to higher levels of innovation, provide them with ideas to be more effective creators of digital learning, and help embed them in professional development networks to support and sustain their excitement for digital learning after the conference."

Topics to be tackled at the conference include: Coding, Robotics, and Artificial

Intelligence in the Classroom; Learning through Play, Assessment Strategies for

Digital Learning, Designing Creative and Innovative Learning; and Future-Focused

Culture of Sustainable Learning.
